1. PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Waupaca County Sheriff's Office is soliciting bids from qualified vendors to supply and install fencing at our Evidence Garage located in Manawa, WI.

2. PROJECT SCOPE AND SPECIFICATIONS

The Sheriff's Office Evidence Garage Fence and Install project involves to purchase and install an 8' high fence to enclose and make secure an area surrounding the Evidence Garage located in Manawa, WI. This fence will include 3 gates and will provide evidence security and management processes.

The fence and install should meet the following minimum specifications:

- a) Fence and gates are to be 8' tall for the entire perimeter
- b) 8' spacing on posts
- c) 8' high heavy duty industrial chain link fence
- d) Fence wire should be 2" x 9 gauge galvanized steel core wire
- e) Fence should be surmounted by (3) strands of barbwire
- f) One 12' opening using double swing gate
- g) One 30' cantilever electric slide gate
- h) One 24' double swing gate
- i) Gate posts are galvanized steel schedule 40 set in 48" concrete footings minimum at 8' center
- j) PVC Privacy slats included in all sections of fence and gates (up to 90% privacy)
- k) Optional - privacy slats included in all sections of fence & gates (98% + privacy)
- l) Line posts are 2 1/2" diameter
- m) Top rail is 1 5/8" diameter
- n) 45 remote transmitters/receivers
- o) Installation must meet State Code
- p) Vendor is responsible for all electrical work

3. QUESTIONS

Any questions pertaining to this bid should be submitted in writing and sent to the contact listed in Section 10 of this document. Bids must be received prior to the 'Questions Due' date and time listed on the Bid Cover Sheet. Any correspondence or questions submitted must include the bid name and number.

Responses to questions will be posted on the County website http://www.co.waupaca.wi.us/businesses/bids_and_proposals.php. Bidders are responsible for checking the website for any addenda prior to submitting a bid.

4. CLEAN-UP

After installation is complete, vendor will make sure any scrap, extra materials, and tools have been removed from the site by walking the perimeter of the fence on both sides. Ensure any debris from construction is swept away from the fence and general area.

5. PROJECT SCHEDULE

The expected project completion date is on or before June 15, 2019. If this date needs to be adjusted, please include your proposed date, as well as your reasoning for shifting the schedule. All proposed date changes will be considered.

6. PROPOSAL REQUIREMENTS

All bids must be received by the due date and time listed on the bid cover sheet in order to be considered. All bids shall contain the following items:

- a) Three (3) copies of complete bid on 8.5" x 11" paper
- b) Attachment A – Bidder Information
- c) Attachment B – References
- d) Attachment C – Price Proposal
- e) Attachment D – Submittal Checklist

7. PROPOSAL SUBMISSION

Bidders must submit three (3) copies of complete proposal, including all required materials for acceptance of their bid by the due date and time listed on the bid cover sheet. All bid received after that date and time will be rejected.

All proposals will be opened and publicly read on April 5, 2019 at 9:30 a.m. in the Waupaca County Law Enforcement Center Conference Room.

9. CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

The following will be considered to evaluate proposals received:

1. Quality and content of company's written proposal
2. Company's history and experience with similar projects
3. Company's proposed lump-sum fee to complete this project

All prices, costs and conditions outlined in the bid shall remain fixed and valid for acceptance for a minimum of ninety (90) calendar days starting on the due date for this bid.

12. APPEALS PROCESS

Notices of intent to protest must be made in writing within seventy-two (72) hours after the time of the bid opening. Protestors should make their protests as specific as possible and should identify Wisconsin Statutes or Waupaca County Ordinance provisions that are alleged to have been violated.
