Our Healthy Connections Clinic offers:

Comprehensive Reproductive Healthcare including:

- Laboratory Services (Pap smear, etc.)
- Sexually Transmitted Disease or Infection (STD/STI) testing and on-site treatment
- Family planning supplies including Depo Provera, Nexplanon, and IUDs
- Emergency contraception
- Condoms (latex and non-latex)
- HIV testing and counseling (at no charge)

All services provided are confidential and are not limited by county residence. We accept Medical Assistance, Family Planning Only Services (FPOS), private insurance, BadgerCare, or you may be eligible for an income-based sliding fee scale. Appointments are recommended but not necessary.

Women, Infants and Children (WIC)



Our WIC Program offers:

- Screening for nutrition and health needs.
- Information on how to use WIC foods to improve health.
- Benefits to buy foods that help keep you and your children healthy and strong.
- Referrals to doctors, dentists, and programs like FoodShare, Medicaid, BadgerCare Plus, Wisconsin Works (W-2), and Head Start.
- Information on healthy eating during pregnancy and breastfeeding.
- Help with starting or continuing breastfeeding.
- Infant formula, if needed.
- Immunization referrals.
- Blood lead testing (recommended at ages 1 and 2 to ensure your child is safe from lead exposure).

To be eligible for WIC benefits in Wisconsin, a person must meet the following requirements:

- Be a pregnant, breastfeeding or new mother; be an infant up to age one; or be a child up to age 5; and
- be a resident of Wisconsin; and
- be income eligible; and
- have a health or nutrition need.

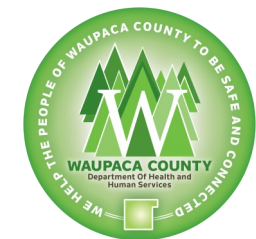

Healthy Beginnings



Our Healthy Beginnings Home visitors offer:

- **Free, voluntary home visits** to provide support for expectant parents and parents of infants and young children. Visits are scheduled to meet your family's needs and availability.
- **Information** on child development, parenting strategies, and activities for you and your child to do together.
- **Developmental, health, hearing, and vision screenings.** These screenings will check to see your child is reaching his/her milestones or is in need of additional help.
- **Home safety reviews** to help make sure your home is as safe as possible for your child.
- **Connections to area resources** and agencies to help meet your family's needs and goals.
- **Monthly group events** for all families in the program. These events give parents a chance to socialize and kids an opportunity to interact and play with other kids.

Environmental Health



Our Environmental Health Specialists offer:

- **Licensing and inspection** for restaurants, retail food facilities, public swimming pools, lodging facilities, campgrounds, recreational and educational campgrounds, tattoo and body piercing, and manufactured home communities.
- **Sampling, testing, and inspecting** of wells at establishments that provide drinking water to the public such as restaurants, bars, churches, parks, and others.
- **Radon consultation** and test kits.
- **A water laboratory** for drinking water testing. Tests available include bacteria, nitrate, and arsenic.
- **Support** in environmental health hazards such as indoor air quality, drinking water quality, surface water quality, sewage concerns, and many other issues.

County residents with a private well (not city water) and a newborn in the home qualify for a free water sample test kit. Call 715-258-6323.

Community Health



Our Public Health Nurses offer:

- **Prenatal Care Coordination (PNCC)** to help pregnant women get the support and services they need to have a healthy baby. Services include: personal support from a Public Health Nurse, information on good eating habits and health practices, information and help finding services in the community, and information on pregnancy and care of a newborn. It is a voluntary and confidential program. Call for program eligibility.
- **Postpartum support** to answer questions and share information on other community resources with new parents.
- **Immunizations** to protect your children from many infectious diseases. Public Health Services offer free immunizations to children who qualify. For more information on vaccinations visit: www.dhs.wisconsin.gov/immunization/vfc.htm.
- **Communicable disease prevention, detection, and control** through community education, disease surveillance, and outbreak response.
