Moderate growing tree with bluish-green needles, and short, dense branches. A popular Christmas tree as well as an ornamental and windbreak tree. Does best in heavy, moist soil. (Deer do not prefer this one)

(White Cedar) Fan-like glossy leaves provide year-round color. Forms a wind tight barrier when used for screening or as hedging. Foliage turns bronze during autumn in the north. Prefers heavy damp areas.

# DECIDUOUS TREES AND SHRUBS

~~**HYBRID POPLAR**~~ (12-24" Seedling) **25/\$20.00** \_\_\_\_\_ **SOLD OUT**  
 Grows approximately 50 feet. Spreads 30 feet. A fast growing tree with large leaves giving lots of shade in a hurry. Soil adaptable.

~~**HIGHBUSH CRANBERRY**~~ (12-18" Seedling) **25/\$20.00** \_\_\_\_\_ **SOLD OUT**  
 Grows to 8 ft. Attractive foliage turns red and orange in the fall. Flat clusters of white flowers followed by red berries.

**BUTTERFLY BUSH** (12-24" Seedling) **25/\$20.00** \_\_\_\_\_ \$ \_\_\_\_\_  
 Perennial, grows 5 ft. tall. Fast growing shrub with long spikes of blue/purple flowers in July/August. Does best in full sun and moist well-drained soil. Cut back in late fall. Attracts butterflies.

**RED OSIER DOGWOOD** (12-18" Seedling) **25/\$20.00** \_\_\_\_\_ \$ \_\_\_\_\_  
 Grows 7 – 9 ft. Spreads 8 – 12 ft. A broad erect grower with dark blood red branches. White flowers followed by white berries. Good for soil erosion and food and cover for wildlife.

~~**EUROPEAN MOUNTAIN ASH**~~ (18-24" Seedling) **25/\$20.00** \_\_\_\_\_ **SOLD OUT**  
 Grows 30 – 40 ft. with a 20-30 ft. spread. Upright, spreading branches for an oval crown. White flowers in May followed by clusters of orange berries in late summer.

~~**OAK – SWAMP WHITE**~~ (12-18" Seedling) **25/\$20.00** \_\_\_\_\_ **SOLD OUT**  
 Back by popular demand. Height and spreads 50-60 ft. Growth rate–moderate. Does well in moist to wet soils, also in upland areas. Shiny dark green leaves. Yellow to purple fall color. Their sweet acorns are great for wildlife.

**OAK – RED** (12 – 18" Seedling) **25/\$20.00** \_\_\_\_\_ \$ \_\_\_\_\_  
 A wide, massive 80-90 ft. shade tree. Fast growing and long-lived oak. This acorn tree provides food and shelter for wildlife and can tolerate city conditions.
