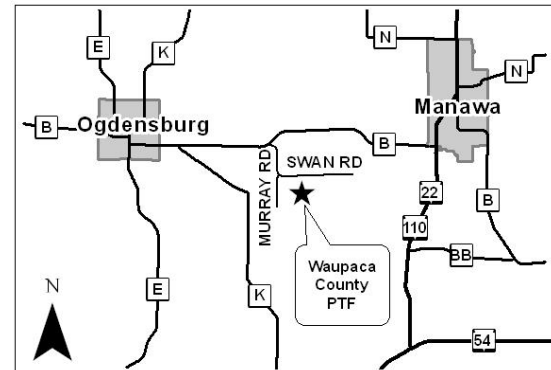

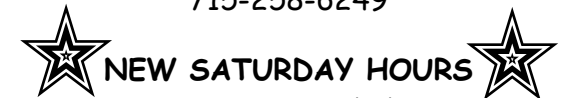

 Trash, furniture, toilets, mattresses, shingles, construction debris, etc.
NO asbestos-containing material accepted at Facility.

1. Green/Brown Glass Bottles
 (food & beverage ONLY)



2. Clear Glass Bottles
 (food & beverage ONLY)



NO window glass, light bulbs, mirrors, dishware, ceramics

3. Plastic Bottles & Containers

- Food/Drink/Detergent, etc.
- Dairy/Produce/Bakery/Deli



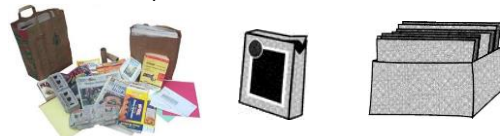
Aluminum Cans

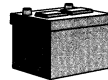
