Medication Collection Program

Year-round at the following locations:

- Clintonville Police Department
- Manawa Police Department
- Marion Police Department
- New London Police Department
- Weyauwega Police Department
- Waupaca County Sheriff Department



ACCEPTED: Prescription and over-the-counter medications, pet medications, supplements

NOT ACCEPTED: Needles, syringes, thermometers, blood pressure kits, glucose monitoring devices



GUIDELINES

- Empty pills into a plastic sealable bag
- Keep liquids, creams, powders in original containers
- Recycle empty pill bottles and paper boxes at home
- Discard plastic caps in the garbage

NOT ACCEPTED: Plastic rope lights, light bulbs

Up to 4 car tires (16" and under) \$ 4.50 per tire (reg. \$5.00)
\$ 9.00 w/ rim (reg. \$10.00)

17" and greater \$ 240 per ton (reg. \$250)

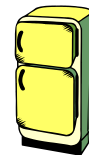
Loads of 5 or more car tires will be weighed to determine charge based on \$240 per ton.

Refrigerator, Freezer, Dehumidifier, Air-Conditioner **\$10.00 ea.** (reg. \$15.00)

Stove, Microwave, Dishwasher, Washer, Dryer, Water Heater, Furnace **\$8.00 ea.** (reg. \$10.00)



WAUPACA COUNTY PTF

Solid Waste: garbage, furniture, toilets, mattresses, shingles, windows, construction & demolition debris, etc.

\$75.00 per ton; \$15.00 minimum charge (up to 400 lbs.)



Recyclables: plastic containers, steel cans, aluminum cans, glass bottles & jars, cardboard, paper, newspaper, magazines - **No Charge**

All open loads must be covered and secured.
Loads must be scaled in 15 min prior to closing.
Payment by cash or check ONLY.

Dispose of your Household Hazardous Waste for less than HALF the regular cost!

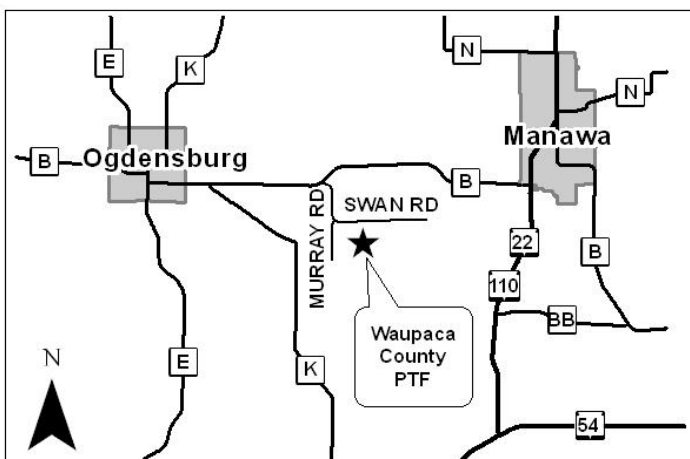
<u>HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE</u>	<u>DISPOSAL COST</u>
Flammable Liquids (gas, charcoal lighter, paint thinner)	\$ 0.40/lb.
*Paint (lead & oil-based only), Stain, Varnish, Shellac	\$ 0.40/lb.
Concrete Sealer, Blacktop Sealer	\$ 0.40/lb.
Halogenated Solvents (degreasers, cleaners)	\$ 0.45/lb.
Aerosols (includes aerosol pesticides)	\$ 0.50/lb.
Acids/Bases (corrosives, drain cleaners)	\$ 0.50/lb.
**Pesticides (non-aerosol), Poisons (cyanide)	\$ 0.60/lb.
Oxidizers (hypochlorite pool chemicals)	\$ 0.60/lb.
Flammable Solids (flares)	\$ 0.65/lb.
Peroxides (hardeners for fiberglass)	\$ 0.65/lb.
Mercury	\$ 0.65/lb.
Mercury Thermometers	\$ 0.35 ea.

* **Latex Paint** will not be accepted. Once **Latex Paint** is dry, it can be put in the trash. **Paint Hardener** (\$2.50/bag) is available at the PTF, the Waupaca County Courthouse, and the Waupaca and Clintonville Area Recycling Centers. One bag will dry approximately 2/3 gallon of **Latex Paint**. This product is for **Latex Paint** only.

** **Pesticides in powder form must be double bagged to ensure containment.**

NOTE: Hazardous waste must be in a container that can be left at the PTF.
