

WAUPACA COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES
Chapter 26
Parking Lot Ordinance

26.01 OBJECTIVES

To regulate the activities conducted in County-owned areas and designated parking areas for employees and visitors to County buildings, the Board of Supervisors of Waupaca County ordains the following regulations:

26.02 PURPOSE

This Ordinance is adopted in order to protect and regulate safety, comfort and convenience of individuals employed and/or conducting business with Waupaca County by controlling the County-owned parking areas.

26.03 DEFINITIONS OF WORDS AND PHRASES

The following words, phrases and terms, wherever they occur in the Ordinance, shall be interpreted as herein defined:

A. County-Owned Parking Area

Any area owned by the County is designated and/or posted as an area for stopping and parking motor vehicles while involved in County business.

B. Visitor

Any individual not in the employ of the County, but present on County property for the purpose of conducting some form of authorized business.

C. Employee

An individual who receives a regular paycheck on a monthly basis from the County, regardless of the number of hours worked. This does not, however, include Waupaca County Board of Supervisors.

D. Tenants

Anyone renting or using office space on a regular scheduled basis within the Courthouse.

26.04 SEVERABILITY CLAUSE

If any section, provision or portion of this Ordinance is adjudicated unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

26.05 GENERAL PROVISIONS

- A.** All employees and tenants utilizing the County-owned parking area shall park in the designated and posted employee parking area(s).
- B.** All visitors utilizing the County-owned parking area(s) while on business with County offices or personnel may park in the designated and posted visitor parking area(s).
- C.** All use of skateboards, remote control vehicles, horseplay or any other activity not part of authorized County business is hereby strictly prohibited.
- D.** Overnight parking shall be approved by the Maintenance Supervisor.

26.06 PENALTY - ENFORCEMENT

- A.** Violation of this Ordinance is punishable by a fine of Ten and 00/100 Dollars (\$10.00) for each violation.
- B.** Enforcement of any violation of this Ordinance will be the responsibility of the City of Waupaca Police Department and the Waupaca County Sheriff's Department.
- C.** Vehicles left in parking lot overnight will be removed at owner's expense.
