

**CHAPTER 45**  
**YEAR 2030 COMPREHENSIVE PLAN**

The County Board of Supervisors of Waupaca County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

- 45.01** Pursuant to section 59.69, Wisconsin Statutes, Waupaca County is authorized to prepare and adopt a comprehensive plan as defined in sections 66.1001(1)(a) and 66.1001(2), Wisconsin Statutes.
- 45.02** Waupaca County has adopted written procedures designed to foster public participation in every stage of the preparation of a comprehensive plan as required by section 66.1001(4)(a), Wisconsin Statutes.
- 45.03** The Waupaca County Zoning and Land Use Planning Committee, by a majority vote of the entire committee recorded in its official minutes, has adopted a resolution recommending to the County Board the adoption of the document entitled "*Waupaca County Year 2030 Comprehensive Plan*" containing all of the elements specified in section 66.1001(2), Wisconsin Statutes.
- 45.04** Waupaca County and its communities have provided numerous opportunities for public involvement in accordance with the Public Participation and Education Plan adopted by the Waupaca County Board including public informational meetings, open Plan Commission/Committee meetings, public opinion surveys, news releases, newsletters, a slogan contest, and a planning process web site. A public hearing was held on August 20<sup>th</sup>, 2007, in compliance with the requirements of Section 66.1001(4), Wisconsin Statutes.
- 45.06** The Waupaca County Board of Supervisors does, by the enactment of this ordinance, formally adopt the two documents composing the "*Waupaca County Year 2030 Comprehensive Plan*" (including the "Plan Recommendations Report" and the "Inventory and Trends Report") pursuant to Section 66.1001(4)(c), Wisconsin Statutes.
- 45.07** This ordinance shall take effect upon passage by a majority vote of the members-elect of the County Board and publication/posting as required by law.
