Please review below and attached for discussion at the December 5 meeting.

At the November 4 special LJESS committee meeting, staff was tasked with the following:

- 1. Update section 2.13 to add webinar, to keep the wording regarding authorization but to update the paragraph to make it clearer
- 2. Research how other counties add or remove member from committees outside of the committees on committees meeting and allowing the chair to appoint himself/herself to any committee.
- 3. Look into wording for breach of closed session rules. Possibly adding to the ethics code.
- 4. Look into section 2.16 "Creating a Subgroup" to make sure that prior subgroups that were created would remain if needed.
- 5. I also requested to be able to look into having per diem Chair/Vice Chair salary and payment for attendance to seminar etc being changed by resolution instead of by ordinance.

Items 1 and 4: The attached draft of Chapter 2 has these updates as noted on pages 18, 19, and 25.

Items 2 and 5: The attached survey shows the responses of the 20 clerks that got back to me. In summary:

- Most do not have a process for removal and if the couple that do either don't have a rule written or if it is written, refers to unexcused absences or being removed by unsatisfactory.
- For adding to the committee if a vacancy accrues, majority say that is a recommendation by the chair.
- For appointing himself/herself to committee, no one had a rule that said they could not. Many stated that they are ex-officio members. Others stated that the committee makeup determined if chair could/would be on it.
